# **CLASSES IX and X**

- 1. The criteria of assessment includes:
- a) 20% Internal Assessment and 80% Final Exam
- b) The Internal Assessment includes:
  - 5% Notebook Submission
  - 5% Subject Enrichment Activities.
  - 5% Multiple Assessments
  - 5% Periodic Tests
- c) There will be three Periodic Tests (PTs) held in a session for 40 marks, 80 marks & 40 marks respectively.
- d) In class IX, the Final Exam will be for 80 marks with full syllabus and in class X there will be a Pre-board Exam and the Final CBSE (AISSE) exam of 80 marks each with full syllabus.

2. The Co-Scholastic Activities will include:

- Art Education
- Health & Physical Education (Includes Work Education)
- Discipline (To be graded by the teachers)
- Assessment will be done on a five point scale (A-E) once in a year.
- No upscaling of grades will be done.

# **CLASSES XI and XII**

- 1. In Class XI, there will be two Unit Tests of each subject during the academic year. Besides this there will be two formal examinations in September and February /March.
- 2. In Class XII, there will be one Unit Test of each subject in the month of May during the academic year. Besides this, two formal examinations will be conducted in the month of September and December/January based on the CBSE examination pattern. The students will appear for the **AISSCE** conducted by the CBSE in the month of **March**.

# Promotion Norms for Classes IX and XI

- All promotions will be based on the CBSE norms.
- The pass percentage in each subject (theory and practical separately) is 33%.
- A student failing in more than one subject will not be promoted.
- Passing in both the theory paper and practical exam is mandatory as per the CBSE guidelines.
- Minimum 75% attendance is required for promotion.

Note: The Progress Profile detail of the students of all classes will be published online after each term. In case, a student's performance is not upto the expected standards it will be discussed with the parent on a one to one basis.
